



Griffiths Family Scholarship for Engineering, Manufacturing and Computer Science

This scholarship was established through the generosity of Harold Griffiths. Strongest consideration will be given to students who can demonstrate their interest in a career in the above named fields. Relevant coursework, activities, community service and employment are considered. While applicants should be all-around citizens, GPA is not the crucial factor for selection.

Criteria:

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating Eden Prairie High School senior who will:

- (1) attend any post-secondary school in Fall 2019 (including public and private—technical schools, 2-year colleges and 4-year colleges);
- (2) enter the field(s) of: (1) manufacturing, (2) engineering, or (3) computer science; and
- (3) has a 3.75 GPA and at least 6 honors credits

Award Amount:

\$3,500 per academic year, renewable for an additional three years, for possible award total of **\$14,000**. The scholarship is renewable contingent on the recipient earning 12-16 credits per quarter (or the school's equivalent of a full load) starting freshman year or equivalent and maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA.

Procedure:

- The application process will take place through Eden Prairie High School's Multi-Scholarship Application process.
- Please complete the Multi-Scholarship application through EPHS's online Naviance system. The system is available from December 14, 2018 – February 6, 2019.
- This scholarship requires a letter of recommendation. Letters of recommendation currently in Naviance will be used. If you do not have a letter of recommendation in Naviance, one must be uploaded by a teacher.
- The top 5 candidates will be required to take part in an interview.
- **Applications are due by 3:00 p.m. on February 6, 2019.**
- A committee will choose the recipient and the scholarship will be awarded at the Community Scholarship Awards night in May 2019.
