Sydney M. Galleger Memorial Scholarship

The Sydney M. Galleger Memorial Scholarship was established by the friends and family of Sydney Galleger, who passed away too soon and unexpectedly from a routine dental procedure June 2015. Sydney attended Eden Prairie Schools from second grade through her junior year at Eden Prairie High School.

Sydney participated and earned a number of varsity letters in Diving, Alpine Skiing and Synchronized Swimming and was a member of DECA. This scholarship focuses on students who participate in these activities.

Criteria:

This scholarship is awarded to an Eden Prairie High School senior who:

- 1) has a grade point average of 2.8 or higher;
- 2) is actively participating in one or more of the following: Swim/Dive team, Alpine Ski team, Synchronized Swim team, or DECA
- 3) serves as a positive role model to others and demonstrates a positive attitude and
- 4) is pursuing some type of post-secondary education – **vocational, junior college, community college, or university.**

Award Amount:

The Sydney M. Galleger Memorial Scholarship is \$2500 per academic year and is not renewable. One scholarship will be awarded to a student participating in one or more of the following activities: Swim/Dive team, Alpine Ski team, Synchronized Swim team, DECA for a total of 4 scholarships awarded in 2019.

Procedure:

- The application process will take place through Eden Prairie High School's Multi-Scholarship Application process using the Naviance system. The system is available from December 14, 2018 – February 6, 2019.
- This scholarship requires a letter of recommendation. Letters of recommendation currently in Naviance will be used. If you do not have a letter of recommendation in Naviance, one must be uploaded by a teacher.
- **Applications are due by 3:00 p.m. on February 6, 2019.**
- A committee will choose the recipients and the scholarships will be awarded at the Community Scholarship Awards night May 2019.
